On behalf of the LaSalle Athletics Organization, we would like to welcome you and your Mite Teams to the 2015 PWSA Provincial Grand Championship Tournament. This year's Tournament is being held at Turtle Club Park in LaSalle, Ontario and will bring together 15 teams and approx. 200 softball players from across the Province.

We have spent countless hours fundraising, organizing and planning for this year's Tournament and we hope we will have made it a most memorable and enjoyable one for all the players and their families who are joining us. 1) <u>TURTLE CLUB PARK - Ball Diamonds</u> – 370 Reaume Road LaSalle, Ontario

Turtle Club Park is the home to the LaSalle Titans, LaSalle Athletics and Turtle Club Houseleague Baseball and Softball programs. Turtle Club Park is a very unique privately owned and volunteer run facility with 7 baseball / softball diamonds, batting cages and playground.

(a) Park Layout:

- We are utilizing 4 Diamonds (TC # 3,4, 5 & 6) shown on this layout. We have identified all key items on this layout. The Tournament Ceremony will be held on TC Diamond # 1 with Skills Competition on Diamond # 1 & 2 concurrently.



(b) **Tournament Parking:**

There are number of locations to park your vehicle at depending on which Diamonds you will play on. Please refer to the layout above to ensure you have found the correct location.

We will be designating <u>"RESERVED PARKING"</u> at certain areas for PWSA and Tourney Directors, as well as providing one parking pass to each team for their Manager or the designate in charge of handling their team's equipment. We respectfully ask all participants to observe and avoid these parking areas unless designated or risk the possibility of having you vehicle towed. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

(c) <u>Concessions:</u>

There is a concession area noted within the park layout that will be open for your use. They will offer a variety of products of expected items.

(d) **Restroom Facilities:**

There are restrooms located next to the concession and we will have Port-a-Johns set up in the park for your use.

2) Tournament Schedule and Key Items:

(a) Game Schedules:

Please refer to the Tourney bracket you received direct from PWSA. We will also have copies of the bracket within the Tournament Program that all Participants will receive.

(b) Manager's Meeting:

PWSA will hold their traditional Coaches Meeting on Friday August 14th at 2:00 pm. The meeting location will be by the Clubhouse near the concession. Please remember to bring in bats not inspected during your Qualifier. After the meeting, our planning committee would like an additional 5 minutes of your time to discuss the plan for the "Opening Ceremonies" for midday on Saturday and also to hand out a team package with programs and other goodies.

(c) <u>Ceremony / Fireworks Extravaganza: Mic Mac Park – Friday Aug 14th 8:45 – 10:00 pm</u>

For those who may not already know, the Windsor Wildcats & LaSalle Athletics are also co-hosting the **2015 PWSA Squirt Provincial Grand Championships at Mic Mac Park in Windsor**.

The two Tournaments are both just off Matchette Road (which runs through both Windsor & LaSalle) and approx. 5 minutes apart from each other. We are attaching the Mic Mac Park Map and Logistics Plan for the Opening Ceremonies which will be held at Mic Mac on Diamond A2.

We very much wish for all Mite teams to join us at Mic Mac Park for this event!!

We have reserved an entire diamond (shown on Logistics plan below) Mic Mac Little League Diamond # A3 for all those Mite players and their families who wish to come out and see the Ceremony and / or the Fireworks display. Please bring your own lawn chairs / blankets with you.

We have also reserved a portion of parking for all Mites players and their families who wish to come out and join us at the John McGivney Children's Center on Matchette Road across the street from Mic Mac Park.

(d) Mite Tournament Ceremonies: Saturday August 15th at 12:30 pm (right after morning games)

- <u>ALL MITE TEAMS</u> (including those playing and those not) to meet near the Parking area between Turtle Club Diamond # 6 & 7 by 12:15 pm, which will have been blocked off prior to allow for a team meeting place. There will be team signs placed for you to meet your players and Coaches at. We ask that all parents stay out of this area after 12:15 pm (to avoid congestion) and to proceed to Turtle Club Diamond # 1 where ceremonies will take place.
- We are planning on a Parade of Teams onto the Diamond A1, a group photo, the National Anthem, some brief speeches by PWSA and other dignitaries and a ceremonial First Pitch.
- We will have a Team sign for each team to carry within the parade. Many of you also have a team banner which you are also welcome to carry in the parade.
- Immediately following the ceremony, at approximately 1:10 pm, we plan to hold a Skills Competition on Turtle Club Diamonds # 1 and # 2 followed by a free lunch provided to all teams.
- All teams to fill out & return a Team Information sheet (attached in electronic format to this Introductory E-mail) to Barry Yetman : <u>byetman@cardinalcontracting.com</u> – NO LATER THAN THURS AUG 13th or your team may miss out on showcasing themselves during the ceremony.

(e) Game MVP Awards:

We will provide teams MVP awards to be presented at the end of each game. Opposing Manager will present to player of their choice on the opposing team at the end of each game.

(f) Team Skills Competition Challenge: Saturday August 15th – 1:15 pm – 1:45 pm

- We will have awards for the best scoring teams (not individuals)
